BRANCH 11 LEADS STATE ASSOCIATION WITH \$30,000 TO IPALC

Branch 11 was recognized at this year's State Convention as the top contributor to our Illinois Political Action Committee. The \$30,000 contribution was the most ever by Branch 11 or any branch in the Illinois State Association. Delegates at this year's convention were provided with gold (\$500) or silver (\$250) badges to acknowledge their level of contribution. A total of 68 members Branch 11 contributed at least \$250. Also during the annual convention, James E. Worsham carrier Denon Oglesby was the recipient of this year's Bybee Award; Claretha Jenkins was inducted to the Illinois State Carriers Hall of Fame; Branch 11 Officers Ronald Morgan and Jesse Reed were newly elected to the State Board while William Bean (Treasurer), William Danger-

field (Asst. Director of Retirees), Antoine Thigpen (Executive Board) and Montago T. McCraney (Sergeant-at-Arms) were elected by acclamation to the State Board.









CONTRACT TALKS BEGIN/ COLA increase \$624 Annually!!

Negotiations for our next collective bargaining agreement officially began on June 26th at Postal Headquarters in Washington, D. C. National President Fred Rolando's opening statement strongly emphasized the need for an improved work environment and a wage increase equivalent to the hard work of City Letter Carriers. Meanwhile, the seventh and last cost of living adjustment (COLA) under the current agreement was announced at \$624 annually, and will be reflected on the September 20 pay day. The 2016-2019 agreement expires at midnight on that same day.
